“Ha Potami” Management Plan

SCOPE:

The Project’s aim was to establish a Management Plan for the “Ha Potami” area of special ecological interest, in order to protect the area’s biodiversity and wetland habitats as well as its ground and water resources.

The Project was carried out in collaboration with the Greek Biotope-Wetland Centre (EKBY). ALA Planning Partnership was responsible for the planning component of the Project and evaluated the land uses, planning zones, road network, technical and social infrastructure of the area and recorded current uses and trends incompatible with the targets set out by the management plan.

RESULTS:

The Project concluded with a set of special targets for the Management Plan and specific measures to serve the needs of each target. Furthermore, recommendations were given regarding the creation of Management Zones within the Study area. The team concentrated on proposing acceptable uses, activities and projects for the wider area and for each management zone, so as to meet the special needs of each zone and the wider purpose of the Management Plan.
